SURROUNDING AREA

The lively, atmospheric city of Dublin is located on the east coast of Ireland. The city offers a unique combination of tradition and modernism, culture and commerce, all with this charming Irish touch. Modern buildings such as the Grand Canal Theatre and the Spire take their place next to such historical building as Trinity College and Leinster House, the parliament building. Rathdown School is a boarding school situated to the south of Dublin in Glenageary. The school provides indoor and outdoor facilities for tennis, hockey, badminton, basketball, handball and football.

Our trainers

Without exception all our trainers are native-speakers of the target language. They are all experienced and enjoy the rewards of working with children and young people. The team is available to work with the camp participants throughout the day: teaching, organizing the afternoon and evening activities and putting their ideas into practice with the children and young people. Each Camp has a Camp Director who has overall responsibility and can, in the event of an emergency, speak with the children in their own language.

LEARNING SUCCESS WITH BERLITZ LANGUAGE CAMPS

The concept behind our language courses:

- Learners divided into homogeneous learning groups at the beginning of the Camp: participants grouped according to language skills.
- Instruction in small groups: 8 to 12 learner maximum.
- Four 45-minute lessons per day with qualified language teacher.
- Excellent teaching methods, including interviews, role plays, presentations and topic-related project.
- At the end of the Language Camp, all participants receive a Berlitz Certificate.

The training program is open to boys and girls at all skill levels and takes place in an international and multi-cultural environment with youngsters from all over the world participating, a blend of cultures and languages that will enrich students' everyday experiences on the course.

TRAINING PROGRAMME

The main objectives of the training programme are as follows:

- To bring Real Madrid CF closer to its fans from all over the world and to let students experience what it means to play for this great club.
- To encourage youngsters to play sport by organising training sessions with a recreational goal.

- To provide an insight into Real Madrid CF's youth training philosophy.
- To promote the ethos of fair play and team spirit, not to mention the social values that sport can instil.
- To teach, improve and perfect technical and tactical aspects of the game.

Coaching sessions are fun as well as educational. Through soccer, and a varied program of fun and innovative educational activities, participants will also learn Real Madrid CF values, such as leadership, fellowship, tolerance and participation. During the stay in each weekly session, the children will be trained by highly skilled professionals both in the sport and the educational aspects.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE TEACHING

Language tuition uses a fun, participative approach to learning and emphasises spoken language skills. The programme is specifically designed for children with an interest in soccer and includes a range of role-plays, pair-work and activities. Created exclusively by Choices International with the language partner Berlitz, the programme develops English or Spanish skills within a soccer context. Students receive 10 lessons of English or Spanish lessons per week, taught by qualified teachers in classes of a maximum size of 15 students. Students are tested on arrival, and placed in classes with other students of approximately the same level.

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KILLARY LANGUAGE CAMP

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SURROUNDING AREA

Killary lies on the shores of Ireland's only fjord in the stunningly beautiful Connemara region. It is set against a backdrop formed by the Mweelrea Mountains to the north, the Maumturk Mountains and the Twelve Bens to the south, interspersed with countless little lakes, moorland, heaths and meadows. They still cut peat in this area today – which is dried and used as a fuel for burning in fireplaces in the winter months. Right on the shores of the fjord we find the Sleepzone Connemara and the Killary Adventure Center, the perfect base for our exciting camp.
